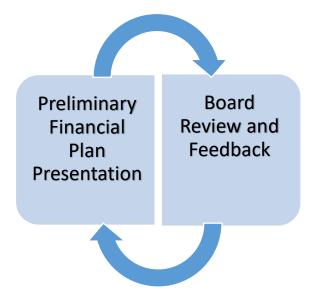

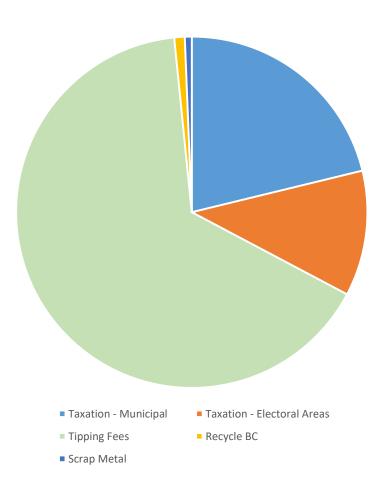
Recommended March 2022

- Guided by Financial Planning Policy
- CSWM board is the authority for the service
- <u>Preliminary</u> plan for initial review and discussion



Revenue

- Taxation maintained at \$5M for 2022
- Consistent w/ September 2020 COVID-19 Response and Renewal report
- Annual taxation of \$76.24 per year for a \$500,000 home*
- Tipping fees remain at \$140 per tonne
- Tipping fee revenue increases in 2022 for organics
 - \$110/tonne starting Sept 2022
- * based on 2021 revised assessment roll

- Updated capital cost projections with a 10 year outlook
- Not likely to be able to maintain at the \$5M level without a big increase in 2026
- Tip fees review for 2023 proposed \$145/tonne*
- * Consistent with neighbouring regional districts



Operational Expenses

- Operating costs increased by 17%, largely attributed to:
 - fracted services due to increase waste volumes and associated transportation costs
 - fraction personnel costs to better support the CSWM service
 - fraction in the support costs directly correlated to capital spending (\$823,822 vs. \$624,060).
 - minor capital for facility improvements
- Reduced wage cost of \$70,349 due to the statutory holiday closure
- Reduced recycling costs of \$190,300 associated with the closure of Canex and Sportplex CSWM non-recycle BC depots



Personnel Costs

- 4 new staff positions in 2022
 - 2 waste management attendants (new)
 - 1 waste management operator (previously approved)
 - 1 environmental technician (new)
- Salaries, wages and benefits 2%
- Engineering Analyst student position (4 months)
- Minor allocation changes between services





Capital Projects

- Capital spending significant next two years
- Funding provided by grants, reserves and debt
 - Organics **\$17.3M**, funded by grants and reserves
 - Landfill closure CRWMC **\$11.6M**, funded by debt
 - Cell 2 CVWMC increased from **\$8.8M to \$13.0M**, funded by reserves
- Debt charges (principle and interest) increasing
