The purpose of this report is to provide information requested by the Comox Strathcona Waste Management Board (Board), related to material utilization from the compost pilot project, since the inception of the project.



## **Executive Summary**

At the September 6, 2018 Board meeting, the Board requested details for material utilization from the Net Zero Waste Compost Pilot Project for each municipality or group. The information below is taken from the scale transaction at the landfill. The total taken from the site is 19,919 tonnes, and the percentage per municipality, or group, is as follows:
