



- A five-year effectiveness review of the current SWMP (2013)
 - What's working (strengths)/ challenges?
 - What initiatives have not yet been completed?
 - Is there a need to amend the existing SWMP?
- Required by the Ministry of Environment

CSWM Performance



What's Working?

- Implemented the majority of SWMP components:
 - Closure of CSWM landfills in compliance with Ministry of Environment requirements
 - Increased diversion of organic waste
 - Continued review of Waste-to-Energy (WTE) as an alternative option to landfilling
 - Increased environmental controls

Initiatives Not Yet Implemented

- Mandatory recycling for multi-family and industrial, commercial, and institutional (ICI) buildings
- Encourage the private and non-profit sectors to develop construction and demolition (C&D) waste recycling services locally

Challenges

- Accurate recording of disposal and diversion quantities
- Improving disposal and diversion
 performance
- Financial sustainability of waste management services





Recommendations

- There is no need to amend the existing Plan before 2023, unless significant changes are proposed, such as a:
 - WTE facility in the service area
 - The opening of a waste management facility that manages wastes that are currently covered by the existing SWMP

Recommendations

- Focus on voluntary reporting until next SWMP update, when a waste stream management licensing system can be considered
- Expand the list of all operational/ permitted landfills in the CSWM service area when SWMP is updated
