required borrowing




# SWMP key objectives



- Increase diversion (reduce, reuse and recycle) to 70 per cent (350 kg/capita)
- Divert organics to support 70 per cent
- Improve waste management in industrial, commercial and institutional (ICI) sectors
- Improve illegal dumping prevention;
- Improve residual waste management
- Explore waste-to-energy technologies and consider for future planning
