RE:	Proposed Water Feature Design and Costs Comox Valley and Campbell River Hospital Campuses	

## Purpose

The purpose of this report is to report back to the committee on the proposed design and costs related to the installation of the water features at both the Comox Valley and Campbell River hospital campuses.

## Recommendation from the Chief Administrative Officer

None. The Board may consider one of three options on this topic:

- Proceed with the proposal from Island Health for \$212,092.93 and incorporate the project into the 2019 proposed financial plan, to be presented to the CSRHD Board in January 2019. Note, this option includes spending the previously allocated \$100,000 in the 2018 financial plan and incorporating the balance in the 2019 financial plan.
- 2) Refer the matter back to staff to reevaluate the project with Island Health and prepare a report for a future select committee or board meeting that includes projects that are valued at the board approved limit of \$50,000 per site.
- 3) That the CSRHD Board not proceed with water features at the hospitals at this time and that the board thank the efforts of the Commemorative Items Select Committee.

## **Executive Summary**

The Comox Strathcona Regional Hospital District (CSRHD) established a select committee to consider matters relating to the investigation and recommendation of a commemorative item for the Comox Valley and Campbell River hospitals in recognition of the service provided by the previous hospitals and all parties that have contributed to the hospitals' construction.

- The Committee and Board approved a bronze plaque for each campus that names the CSRHD Board of Directors; the plaques are now installed at each campus.
- The Committee and Board approved design parameters and a budget in June 2017 for a commemorative water feature at each facility attached as Appendix A. The water features would include a small bronze plaque at each facility.
- Island Health has worked with its onsite contract manager to develop a detailed design and cost estimate based on the CSRHD parameters and budget. The proposal from Island Health is for \$212,092.93.

This plaque was dedicated by the 2017 Comox Strathcona Regional Hospital District Board members: project costs being more Chair Chartle Comfield than twice the previously Cim Abram Michole Babchuk Notis Anderson Julia Coltonna allocated funds. Staff Edile Erskanon Marg Grant Edwin Grieve Larry Jangula commend the Committee's **Bruce dolline** Ron Ker Roger Kish Brenda Leigh Inho MacDonald **Rod Nichol** Larry Sameon Manager Swift Manno Theos Brist Under **Beb Wwill General Wheeler** 

and Board's efforts to celebrate and recognize the health care practitioners who provide care throughout the region; and those efforts can be seen in the North Island Hospitals Project campuses themselves and also the bronze plaques currently

installed at each campus (photos 1 and 2). The Board may consider option 3 above and in future consider ongoing community partnerships with Island Health, hospital foundations and other key stakeholders.

Staff have identified three options for the Board's consideration, as noted above. In considering the Board's mandate with respect to funding acute care facilities, staff have identified concerns relating to the expenditure of funds on the water features project, in particular given the

CSRHD Board approved parameters for water features at the Campbell River and Comox Valley North Island Hospitals Campuses

The features will be based on the these parameters

- Location as agreed on March 31, 2017 (as noted here <u>http://agendaminutes.csrhd.ca/Agenda\_minutes/HospitalCommittee/CISC/31-Mar-17/20170331%20\_CSRHDcommemorative\_v1.pdf</u>: "Quiet Pond" at Comox Valley, and "Quiet Pond Option B" at Campbell River)
- Waterfall with catch pool (purpose for masking of background noise)
- Approximately 6 feet to 8 feet wide and tall
- Lighting and seating
- Curved to match landscape
- Complements building style, colour and landscaping
- Completion in timely manner
- Minimal maintenance requirements
- Estimated cost of \$50,000 at each location

The CSRHD Board also approved the following wording to be used on the dedication plaques for the water feature to be constructed for each hospital:

Dedicated by the 2017 Comox Strathcona Regional Hospital District Board
