Primary Care Network Comox Valley

- Comox Valley was one of the first BC communities to be approved by the Ministry of Health
- Integrated and coordinated health system for primary and community care
- Service plan submitted in August; currently working with the MoH regarding requests for service and staff.

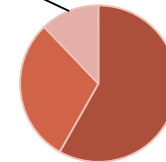
Who is dying and where?

Opioid Crisis

- Campbell River is one of the 20 BC communities most impacted by the overdose crisis. The Campbell River Overdose Community Action Team has received \$100,000 in funding from the Ministry of Mental Health and Addictions' Overdose Emergency Response Centre to support community-led overdose initiatives.
- Overdose prevention sites in both Campbell River and Comox Valley managed by AVI (AIDS Vancouver Island) have not been as well utilized as those in other communities,
- Need for new service models including outreach to support those using drugs alone at home.
- Post-overdose ED follow up has been initiated in Campbell River and has facilitated connections with care (will be initiated in Comox Valley this year)

Surgical Services

- Focus on a Hip and Knee Centre
- Open additional operating room (OR) capacity
- Improve access to surgical beds
- Focus on necessary physicians/staff
- Implement a strategy focusing on reducing the number of long-waiting cases

Other Updates



Indigenous Health

- Spread cultural humility planning throughout Island Health's catchment area with a focus on Emergency Departments
- Conduct reviews to identify barriers to access to acute and community services (including Virtual Care)
- Work with traditional healers/practitioners to identify opportunities for integration and where applicable begin implementation

Community Service

- Island Health, FNHA and other stakeholders are collaborating
- Similar to Jeneece Place
- Goal: a residence in Campbell River for families from the North Island to stay
- And a hostel – for those who have missed a ferry or been discharged late
